ANNUAL REPORT (March 2021 - March 2022)

Honourable President, Vice Presidents, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, Executive Council Members, former office bearers, respected Fellows and Life Members of the Academy;

The last Annual General Body Meeting of KAS was held on 18th, December, 2021, at Central Laboratory for Instrumentation and Facilitation (CLIF), University of Kerala, Karyavattom, Thiruvananthapuram.

Hereby, with great pleasure, as the General Secretary of the academy, I am reporting the activities of the Academy for March 2021 - March 2022, for discussion and endorsement by the General Body of KAS.

1. Membership

The Academy has 13 Hon. Fellows, 68 Fellows and 624 Life Members till 31.03.2022. During the reporting year 36 new life members joined the Academy and I am happy to welcome all the new Life Members to the Academy and urge their continuous support in the activities of KAS.

2. Science Popularization Activities

The Academy has continued its pursuits towards science popularisation in the State through conducting several programmes including outreach programmes to school students, international seminars on specialised topics, important science and technology day observations, commemorative programmes and facilitation programmes. The academy could collaborate with several leading national R&D institutions as well as with academic institutions in organizing the programmes.

I. KAS has partnered with the Department of Zoology, University of Kerala in organizing an International Webinar on the 'Relevance of Omics and Regenerative Medicine in the Pandemic Situation- Fifth Edition', on April 22nd, 2021. Sudhakaran, Former President, KAS delivered the special address in the inaugural function. Prof. (Dr.) Mohamed M. El-Shazly, German University, Cairo, Egypt; Prof. (Dr.) M. Fawzi Mahomoodally, University of Mauritius, Mauritius; Dr. K. V. Prof. Thanu Padmanabhan Memorial Lecture was delivered by Prof. (Dr.) George Varghese, former Director of Kerala State Council for Science, Technology & Environment (KSCSTE), Thiruvananthapuram, on December 18th, 2021, as a prelude to the Annual General Body meeting-2021, at Central Laboratory for Instrumentation and Facilitation (CLIF), University of Kerala, Karyavattom, Thiruvananthapuram.
